REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING

Since the Dive Team members had to leave at 6:30PM, the meeting started with Chief Barlow's report. The career firefighters and a few volunteers participated in a Rescue Challenge, on April 29th through May 3rd, 2018, in Virginia Beach, VA.

There will be a short memorial service at Mt. Hope Cemetery, after the Memorial Day parade.

All equipment is in good working order. Chairman Komjathy commended the firefighters and the Union's efforts in keeping the inside and outside of the building neat and clean.

It was decided to charge the New Hope-Lambertville Greater Area Chamber of Commerce the prevailing FEMA rate for having the fire truck at the fireworks and paid overtime for the career firefighters. The Chief wants an indemnification document for the men when they are working the fireworks.

The purchasing of dive equipment is finished.
